



Cephalotaxus harringtonii

'Fastigiata'



Height	3 - 5 m
Crown	columnar, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	reddish brown, young twigs light green
Leaf	needles shiny dark green, 3 – 5 cm
Flowers	cream, in small hanging cones, 3 – 7 mm, oval, green
Fruits	oval, 1.5 – 2.5 cm long, discolouring from green to purple
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, sandy soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	7a (-17,7 to -15,0 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	can withstand wind
Application	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
