



Picea breweriana



Height	20 – 30 (35) m
Crown	broad conical, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	twigs light red to reddish brown, bark grey, smooth to slightly shallow grooved
Leaf	stiff, spirally set, forward, glossy dark green, 1.5 - 3 cm long, underside with two greenish white lenticel stripes
Flowers	light brown to orange brown, 2 - 2.5 cm, green, purple when ripe
Fruits	slightly curved, cylindrical cones, 8 - 12 cm long and 3 - 4 cm wide, reddish brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil, suitable for wet soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6b (-20,5 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens
