



Pinus ponderosa



Height	20 - 30 (65) m
Crown	narrow conical, light, open crown
Bark and branches	twigs orange-brown, bark orange-yellow to red-brown with dark brown to brown-black markings, flaking in large rectangular and elongated plates
Leaf	stiff needles, slightly twisted, 2 - 3 together, 15 - 25 cm long, green
Flowers	bright (purple) red, yellow when ripening green
Fruits	broad-oval to oval-round, 5 - 12 cm long, reddish brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil, all soil types
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
Application	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens, windbreaks
Shape	clearstem tree
