



Taxus cuspidata f. nana



Height	1-2 m
Crown	flatened spherical, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	reddish brown bark, peeling, twigs green
Leaf	green, evergreen
Flowers	yellow, green, flowers in March
Fruits	brown-black seeds, 4/5 covered by fleshy, red case
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	has toxic components
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6b (-20,5 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
