



## Taxus xmedia 'Hillii'



Height	3 - 5 m
Crown	ovoid/egg-shaped
Bark and branches	twigs brown, bark reddish brown, later fibrous peeling
Leaf	needles, arranged in two rows to spiral, center, 2–2.5 cm long
Flowers	inconspicuous, masculine, yellow buds
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	sandy, loamy soil, well-permeable
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, industrial areas, large gardens, patio gardens
