



## Acer campestre 'Anny's Globe'



<b>Height</b>	3-5 m
<b>Crown</b>	round/spherical, dark, dense crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	palmetely lobed with (3) 5 lobes, about 10 cm long and broad, dark green
<b>Autumn colour</b>	yellow
<b>Flowers</b>	yellowgreen, flowers in May
<b>Fruits</b>	redgreen, inconspicuous
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	all
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates partial paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good/very good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt, valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	narrow streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, coastal areas, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
