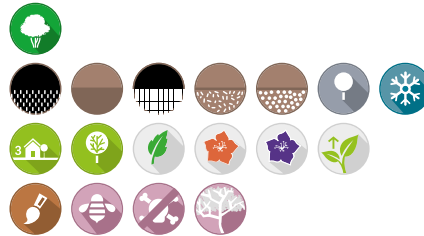




Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum'



Height	4 m
Crown	round, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	rough grey bark, rose branches
Leaf	deeply cut, green, 6 - 10 cm, orange-red autumn colour
Autumn colour	orange, red
Flowers	pendent stalked panicles, purple red, April/May
Fruits	winged nutlet, 1 - 1.5 cm
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	well permeating humic sandy soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
Origin	China, Japan and Korea

Medium, compact tree about 4m high. Deeply incised, narrow green leaves in the autumn faded to a beautiful red / orange color. This Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum' is very Winter hardy. Beautiful characteristic shape. The leaves are sensitive to combustion, prefer a sheltered growing place. The bark is grey with pink branches.
