



Alnus x spaethii 'Spaeth'



Height	15 - 20 m, fast growing
Crown	broad conical, half-open crown
Bark and branches	grey
Leaf	green, purple
Flowers	brown/yellow, flowers in January
Fruits	dark violet
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil, withstand short flood, withstand long flood
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, cemeteries, coastal areas, industrial areas, large gardens, windbreaks
Shape	clearstem tree
