## Aralia elata



Height	8 – 10(15) m
Crown	vase-shaped, light, open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	branches and bark grey, with sharp spines
Leaf	double pinnate compound leafs, 40-100 (140 cm), leaf segments ovate, 6-12 cm, green
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red
Flowers	in large plumes upto 35cm long, cream white, flowers in August
Fruits	black, 6mm
Spines/thorns	Yes
Toxicity	has toxic components
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil, withstand short flood
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	not good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
