



Camellia sasanqua



Height	2 – 5 m
Crown	ovoid / egg-shaped, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	twigs reddish brown to green, bark greyish brown to grey, smooth
Leaf	evergreen, ovate to elliptical, 3-7.5 cm long, glossy dark green
Flowers	axillary, single or in pairs, 5-7.5 cm, in many colours, September-December
Fruits	woody capsule, dark green, later lignified brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	7b (-14,9 to -12,3 °C)
Wind resistance	good, no sea wind
Other resistances	can withstand wind
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
