



Celtis caucasica



Height	10 – 12 m
Crown	round/spherical, half-open crown
Bark and branches	twigs with soft hair, green, bark grey, smooth
Leaf	crooked ovoid to oblong, 5-10 cm long, green
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	inconspicuous, yellow-green, April
Fruits	drupe, 8 mm, yellow to brown-red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, valuable for butterflies
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree
