



Fraxinus excelsior 'Heterophylla Pendula'



Height	4-6 m
Crown	broad weeping, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green, feathered leaf
Flowers	yellowgreen, flowers in April
Fruits	little
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Soil moisture	suitable for wet soil
Paving	tolerates partial paving
Winter hardness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
Application	parks, squares, cemeteries, coastal areas, industrial areas, large gardens
