




## **Hippophae rhamnoides 'Hergo'**



<b>Height</b>	2-4 m
<b>Crown</b>	broad vase-shaped, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, grey-green
<b>Autumn colour</b>	yellow
<b>Flowers</b>	yellow
<b>Fruits</b>	yellow, orange
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	Yes
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, nutrient-poor soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	very good, also sea wind
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt, provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, coastal areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	multi-stem tree
