



Lindera benzoin



Height	3-5 m
Crown	vase-shaped, half-open crown
Bark and branches	twigs green to olive-green-brown, bark brown-grey, slightly grooved
Leaf	elliptical to obovate, 7-12 cm long, bright green
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	unisexual, green-yellow, in dense axillary bundles, March-April
Fruits	berry-shaped drupe, 1-1.8 cm long, red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardness zone	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	multi-stem tree
