



## Magnolia kobus ISIS ('Maráczy')



<b>Height</b>	8-10 m
<b>Crown</b>	columnar, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, bronze
<b>Flowers</b>	cream white, flowers in March
<b>Fruits</b>	red
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, feathered tree, multi-stem treem
<b>Synonyms</b>	Magnolia kobus 'Isis'

Medium-size tree with a regular, columnar to narrow ovoid crown and a straight central leader. The tree eventually grows to about 10 m tall. The young twigs are yellow-green and somewhat lighter than on *M. kobus*. The mature bark is typical of the species. The leaves are ovate to elliptical and 6 - 17 cm long. They are bronze-coloured on emerging, turning dark green in summer. The flowers appear even on young trees. The soft-haired flower buds open into pure white, star-shaped flower buds with 6 petals. These are creamy white. Suitable for avenues, streets and squares.
