Magnolia 'Yellow Lantern'



Height	8-10 m
Crown	ovoid / egg-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	lemon-yellow, flowers in May, fragrant flowers
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates partial paving
Winter hardiness zone	6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem

Medium-size, single or multi-stemmed tree, initially with a columnar crown, later narrow ovoid. Grows rather vigorously, especially when young, and grows up to 8 - 10 m high. The large flowers are tulip-shaped and have even, light lemon yellow petals. The flowers open in May. After blossoming, fruits form abundantly. Due to its slender crown, 'Yellow Lantern' is suitable as an avenue tree as well as a park or garden tree.
