



## Malus 'Gorgeous'



<b>Height</b>	6-8 m
<b>Crown</b>	round/spherical, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown, grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Flowers</b>	white, flowers in May
<b>Fruits</b>	red
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree

Malus 'Gorgeous' has a round crown and grows to a height of 5 - 6 m. The oval leaves are a fresh colour of green. It produces abundant white flowers in May. They are 3.5 - 4 cm in diameter and are pink when in bud. The flowers are single. After flowering the glossy red fruits appear, Ø up to 4 cm. The tree can be used in broad green verges, parks and gardens. It makes heavy demands of the soil as regards moisture supply and fertility. 'Gorgeous' is slightly sensitive to scab. Winter hardiness zone: 5
