



## Malus robusta 'Persicifolia'



<b>Height</b>	5 m
<b>Crown</b>	broad vase-shaped, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown, grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Flowers</b>	white, pink, red, flowers in April, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	red
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayey soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardness zone</b>	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	parks, squares, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree
