

## Oxydendrum arboreum



Height	8-10 (25) m
Crown	oval, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	twigs olive green, bark dark grey-brown, deeply grooved
Leaf	ovate-lanceolate, 8-15 cm long, slightly leathery, glossy dark green
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red, purple
Flowers	white, in pendulous panicles up to 25 cm long, individual flowers urn-shaped, 6-8 mm, July-August
Fruits	dry drupe, light greenish yellow, long lasting
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens
