



## Platanus ×hispanica



<b>Height</b>	20 - 30 (35) m, fast growing
<b>Crown</b>	round, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey-green and yellow-green flaking bark
<b>Leaf</b>	palmately lobed, green, 12 - 25 cm
<b>Flowers</b>	spherical flowering heads, yellow-green, May
<b>Fruits</b>	spherical, spiky, brown, usually 2 together
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	all, soil not too calcareous
<b>Soil moisture</b>	withstand short flood, withstand long flood
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	moderate to good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, cemeteries, large gardens, windbreaks
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree
<b>Origin</b>	Oxford, England, ca. 1670
<b>Synonyms</b>	Platanus hybrida, Platanus ×acerifolia

Aanvulling: There are various clones in circulation, which can vary in detail and hardiness.
