



Populus x canadensis 'Hees'



Height	20-25 m, fast growing
Crown	broad ovoid, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	green, flowers in April
Fruits	greenbrown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, coastal areas, windbreaks
Shape	clearstem tree

Populus x canadensis 'Hees' This female cultivar has a more or less straight trunk with long, upward-pointing branches. The tree has a broad ovoid crown whose branches later bend downwards. The young leaves emerge fairly late and are light green in colour. The tree produces flowers in the form of female catkins. 'Hees' is very resistant to rust and canker and resistant to leaf spot disease. It is resistant to wind, even in coastal regions. Winter hardness zone: 4
