



# Prunus ×yedoensis 'Shidare-yoshino'



<b>Height</b>	2 - 3 m, depending on graft height
<b>Crown</b>	broad, weeping, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Bark and branches</b>	twigs light brown, bark grey-brown, smooth
<b>Leaf</b>	broad oval, green, 6 - 12 cm, autumn colour yellow
<b>Autumn colour</b>	yellow
<b>Flowers</b>	white, about 2 cm, buds light pink, April, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	none, fruitless cultivar
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	any: not in wet soils
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	fairly
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
<b>Application</b>	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree
<b>Origin</b>	Japan

Prunus x yedoensis 'Shidare-yoshino' is a fast growing decorative weeping form that is usually grafted on a stem. Height and width 2 - 3 m. The branches grow vertically downwards. The wide oval leaves are 6 - 12 cm long. They emerge green and remain so the entire summer. The autumn colour is yellow. Abundant flowers in early April. The opened flower buds are pale pink, almost white and smell of almonds. Flower diameter approx. 2 cm. No fruits. Suitable as an arbour tree. Winter hardiness zone: 6a
