| Height | 4-7 m |
| Crown | broad ovoid, half-open crown, capricious growing |
| Bark and branches | brown |
| Leaf | green |
| Flowers | white, slightly fragrant, flowers in April-May |
| Fruits | edible fruits, greenish yellow |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C) |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6) |
| Fauna tree | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant) |
| Application | parks, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens |
| Shape | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem |
