



Prunus 'Kiku-shidare-zakura'



Height	4-6 m
Crown	broad weeping, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown
Leaf	green, bronze
Flowers	light pink, flowers in April
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree
Synonyms	Prunus serrulata 'Kiku-shidare', Prunus serrulata 'Shidare-zakura'
