



Prunus serrulata 'Ichiyo'



Height	5-6 m
Crown	broad vase-shaped, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown
Leaf	green, brown green
Autumn colour	yellow, orange
Flowers	light pink, flowers in April
Fruits	little
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil

Prunus serrulata 'Ichiyo' is often top-grafted and can attain a height of 6 m. The tree has a flattened, broad, vase-shaped crown. The leaves emerge a weak brownish-green, turning dark green later. The tree flowers from mid-April to mid-May, producing double pale pink flowers. These are approx. 5 cm in diameter and grow together in long-stemmed hanging bunches. For parks and public gardens. Its wide crown makes 'Ichiyo' less suitable for streets. It does not stand up to wet soil. Winter hardiness zone: 6a
