

Pterostyrax corymbosa



Height	10 - 15 m
Crown	oval, half-open crown
Bark and branches	branches gray to gray brown: bark grey-brown, grooved
Leaf	obovate to oval, 6-14 cm long, glossy green
Flowers	in panicles, 3-6 cm long, flowers approx. 1 cm large, white, June
Fruits	drupe, obovate, 1.2-2.2 cm, densely hairy
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	7a (-17,7 to -15,0 °C)
Wind resistance	not good
Fauna tree	valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
