



# Pyrus communis 'Clapp's Favourite'

| Height                | 4-7 m  |
| Crown                 | broad pyramidal, half-open crown   |
| Bark and branches     | brown  |
| Leaf                  | green  |
| Flowers               | white, flowers in April-June   |
| Fruits                | edible fruits, yellow-green, red blush                                     |
| Spines/thorns         | None   |
| Toxicity              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock                    |
| Soil type             | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil                       |
| Paving                | tolerates partial paving   |
| Winter hardiness zone | 5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)   |
| Wind resistance       | good, also on the coast  |
| Other resistances     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind                          |
| Fauna tree            | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds |
| Application           | parks, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens                         |
| Shape                 | clearstem tree, feathered tree   |
