



Quercus × hispanica



Height	10-15(30)m
Crown	vase-shaped, half-open crown
Bark and branches	twigs glossy brown, densely hairy, bark dark grey, thick and grooved
Leaf	elongated to ovate, 5-12 cm long, deep green
Flowers	catkins, pale yellow, 4-7 cm long, may
Fruits	long ovoid acorn, 3-4 cm long
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	7 (-17,7 to -12,3 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
Application	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree
Origin	Southern France, Spain, Portugal, Italy and the Balkans
