



## Quercus gambelii



<b>Height</b>	8-12 (20) m
<b>Crown</b>	vase-shaped, dark, dense crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey, reddish brown
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Flowers</b>	yellowgreen, flowers in May
<b>Fruits</b>	green
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayey soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil, suitable for wet soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates partial paving
<b>Winter hardness zone</b>	3 (-40,0 to -24,5 °C)
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Application</b>	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens
