



Rhus typhina



Height	3-6 m
Crown	broad vase-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	soft hairy
Leaf	green, pinnate leaves
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red
Flowers	yellow-green, flowers in June-July
Fruits	red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, nutrient-poor soil, all soil types
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
Application	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
