



# Robinia pseudoacacia 'Nyírségi'

| Height                | 20 - 25 m, fast growing  |
| Crown                 | oval, half-open crown  |
| Bark and branches     | twigs olive green to brown, large thorns, bark grey-brown, deeply grooved                              |
| Leaf                  | odd-pinnate, 20 - 30 cm, 9 - 19 leaf segments, 1.5 - 4.5 cm, dark blue-green, feathered leaf           |
| Flowers               | rare blossoms, in pendent racemes to 10 cm, cream white, about 2 cm, fragrant, June , fragrant flowers |
| Fruits                | very few, flat leathery pod, reddish brown, 5 - 10 cm  |
| Spines/thorns         | Yes  |
| Toxicity              | has toxic components   |
| Soil type             | few requirements as long as well drained   |
| Soil moisture         | suitable for dry soil  |
| Paving                | tolerates paving   |
| Winter hardiness zone | 5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)   |
| Wind resistance       | moderate to good   |
| Other resistances     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt  |
| Application           | avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens, windbreaks     |
| Shape                 | clearstem tree, multi-stem tree  |
| Origin                | Hungary, before 1980   |
