



## Salix alba subsp. vitellina



<b>Height</b>	10-15 m, fast growing
<b>Crown</b>	oval, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	yellowbrown
<b>Leaf</b>	green, greygreen
<b>Flowers</b>	yellow, flowers in April
<b>Fruits</b>	fruitless cultivar
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for wet soil, withstand short flood, withstand long flood
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardness zone</b>	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	fairly
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens, windbreaks
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem tree
