## Sorbus aria 'Majestica'



Height	8-12 m
Crown	broad ovoid, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	white, flowers in May
Fruits	orange, red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly to good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
Application	avenues and broad streets, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree

This tree forms a compact, broad, pyramidal crown. Height 8 - 12 m. At a later stage the crown becomes broad ovoid with fairly dense and closed branches. Because of its slow growth rate and the fact that it stands up well to hard surfaces 'Majestica' is a good avenue and street tree. The flowers are the same as those of the species. The leaves are considerably larger and have practically no autumn coloration. They remain on the tree until well into November. The large fruits are dark orange-red but not very remarkable. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
