| Crown | columnar, half-open crown |
| Bark and branches | grey |
| Leaf | green, feathered leaf |
| Autumn colour | red, purple |
| Flowers | white, flowers in May |
| Fruits | yellow, orange |

| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil |
| Soil moisture | suitable for dry soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C) |
| Wind resistance | good |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind |
| Fauna tree | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds |
| Application | avenues and broad streets, narrow streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens |
| Shape | clearstem tree |
