



## Sorbus folgneri 'Emiel'



<b>Height</b>	10 m
<b>Crown</b>	round, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	young twigs grey-white felt-like hair, later brown, bark grey-brown, smooth
<b>Leaf</b>	narrow ovate to elongated, 5 to 10 cm, glossy dark green
<b>Autumn colour</b>	orange, red
<b>Flowers</b>	white. Ø approx. 1 cm, in approx. 10 cm-wide corymbs, May
<b>Fruits</b>	red, oval
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	few requirements, well-drained soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem

Elegant medium-size tree with round crown shaped by gracefully pendulous branches. Grows to approx. 10 m tall and wide. The young twigs have thick grey-white felt-like hair. The hair disappears later leaving brown branches. Old bark is grey-brown and smooth. The simple leaves are narrow ovate to elongated and taper to a point at the base and tip. On emerging the leaf has grey-white felt-like hair like the young twigs. The mature leaf is glossy dark green and turns deep orange-red in autumn. In May the approx. 1 cm white flowers open in 10 cm corymbs. They are followed by oval, red fruits. Graceful, healthy tree for parks and wide green borders.
