



## Tilia argentea



<b>Height</b>	25-30 m
<b>Crown</b>	broad conical, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, greygreen
<b>Flowers</b>	light yellow, flowers in July, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	green, grey
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, coastal areas, industrial areas, large gardens, windbreaks
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree
