| Height                | 2-3 m  |
| Crown                 | broad oval, dark, dense crown  |
| Bark and branches     | brown  |
| Leaf                  | green  |
| Flowers               | white, white-pink, flowers in November-May   |
| Fruits                | blue, black  |
| Spines/thorns         | None   |
| Toxicity              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock  |
| Soil type             | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil   |
| Soil moisture         | suitable for dry soil  |
| Paving                | tolerates no paving  |
| Winter hardiness zone | 7b (-14,9 to -12,3 °C)   |
| Wind resistance       | good   |
| Other resistances     | can withstand wind   |
| Fauna tree            | can withstand wind, valuable for bees (honey plant)  |
| Application           | parks, tree containers, cemeteries, coastal areas, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens |
| Shape                 | multi-stem treem   |
