



# Styphnolobium japonicum

## 'Pendula'



<b>Height</b>	depending on the grafting height, 4 - 8 m
<b>Crown</b>	broad weeping, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown, grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, feathered leaf
<b>Flowers</b>	cream white, flowers in July
<b>Fruits</b>	grey
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	has toxic components
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	moderate
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt, valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, industrial areas, large gardens, small gardens
<b>Synonyms</b>	Sophora japonica 'Pendula'
