



Rhododendron luteum



Height	1-1,5 m, fast growing
Crown	round/spherical, dark, dense crown
Leaf	green, evergreen
Flowers	flowers in May, June, fragrant flowers
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	has toxic components
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates partial paving
Winter hardiness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	parks, squares, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens, patio gardens
Shape	azaleas

A deciduous upright rhododendron. The young shoots and foliage are a bit sticky. Flowers before the leaves develop, with shapely, strongly scented bright yellow flowers and a somewhat darker macula. Wild species from the Caucasus and Asia Minor.
