



Koelreuteria bipinnata



Height	9-12 m
Crown	irregularly round
Bark and branches	twigs dark brown, bark grey-brown, slightly grooved
Leaf	double to triple pinnate, up to 50 cm long, leaves smooth-edged
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	yellow, in large terminal panicles up to 30 (50) cm long, August-September
Fruits	vesicular, pink to pink-red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	makes very few demands on the soil, stands up to dry conditions
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	7 (-17,7 to -12,3 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Fauna tree	valuable for butterflies
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
