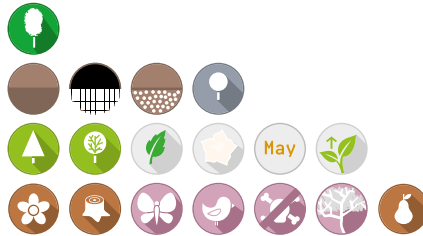




## Cornus nuttallii 'Portlemouth'

| Height                | 6-8 m   |
| Crown                 | pyramidal, capricious growing   |
| Bark and branches     | reddish brown to grey, flaking in small plates  |
| Autumn colour         | red   |
| Flowers               | greenish yellow in heads, inconspicuous, bracts white, may                                    |
| Fruits                | ovoid berry-like drupe, Ø 1 cm, bright red  |
| Spines/thorns         | None  |
| Toxicity              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock                                       |
| Soil type             | soil rich in humus content and moisture-retentive   |
| Paving                | tolerates no paving   |
| Winter hardiness zone | 7a (-17,7 to -15,0 °C)  |
| Wind resistance       | moderate  |
| Fauna tree            | provides food for birds   |
| Application           | parks, tree containers, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens |
| Shape                 | clearstem tree  |
