



Acer circinatum



Height	8 - 10 m
Crown	round, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	bark reddish brown, bark grey, smooth trunk, branches green
Leaf	palmately lobed with 7 - 9 (11) lobes, up to about 9 cm long and 11 cm wide, matte green
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red
Flowers	white with purple-red calyxes, about 1 cm in size, mid-April
Fruits	single-seed, winged nutlets ,always paired
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	fertile, well-drained
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens, windbreaks
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
