



## Carpinus henryana



Height	6 – 8 (15) m
Crown	oval
Bark and branches	twigs purplish brown, bark grey, smooth, later grooved
Leaf	narrow elliptical to lanceolate, 5-9 cm, dark green
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	yellow green, April
Fruits	fruiting catkins, 6-7 cm
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil, suitable for wet soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
