



Cryptomeria japonica 'Sekkan'



Height	6-10 m
Crown	pyramidal
Bark and branches	young growth shoots sulphur-yellow, later from yellow to green-yellow and yellow-green
Leaf	green, evergreen
Flowers	inconspicuous, flowers in April
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
