Larix decidua 'Puli'



Height	depending on the height of the graft union
Crown	broad, weeping, light, open crown, capricious growing
Leaf	green
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	reddish brown, yellowish, flowers in April
Fruits	spherical cone
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	3 (-40,0 to -24,5 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
