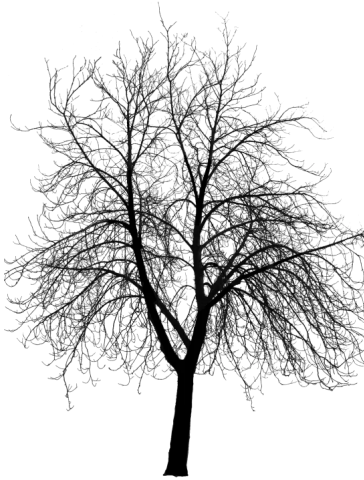
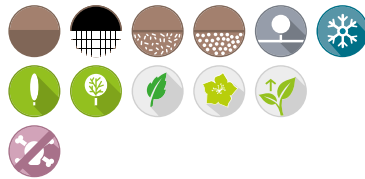




Liquidambar styraciflua 'Oakville Highlight'



Height	5-10 m
Crown	columnar
Bark and branches	brown-grey, grooved
Leaf	palmete, 5-7 lobed
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red, purple
Flowers	yellow-green, inconspicuous, flowers in April-May
Fruits	spiky capsule, brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Application	narrow streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
