



## Osmanthus delavayi



Height	1,5-3 m
Crown	round dense
Bark and branches	twigs green, bark dark grey, smooth
Leaf	evergreen, oval, 1-3 cm, leathery, flossy dark green
Flowers	white, in axillary and terminal bundles, 1-1.5 cm, April
Fruits	stone fruit, oval, blue black
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates partial paving
Winter hardiness zone	8a (-12,2 to -9,5 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	can withstand wind
Fauna tree	can withstand wind, valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
