



Ostrya carpinifolia 'F.C. Moree'



Height	12 - 15 m
Crown	regular branches, pyramidal crown
Bark and branches	brown-grey, grooved, branches olive green
Leaf	ovoid to oval, green, double serrated leaf edge, 5 - 10 cm
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	yellow-green catkins, ? about 4 - 6 cm, ? catkins shorter, April
Fruits	nutlets, in fruit resembling hops
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	likes calcareous soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates paving
Winter hardiness zone	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, squares, cemeteries, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
