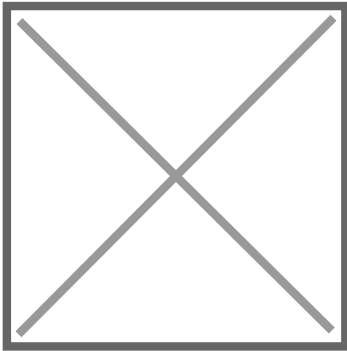




Physocarpus opulifolius 'Diabolo'



Height	2-3 m
Crown	flatened spherical
Bark and branches	bark grey-brown, flaking
Flowers	pinkish white, flowers in May-June
Fruits	brown-red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	all, acid soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	3 (-40,0 to -24,5 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, cemeteries, roof gardens, large gardens, small gardens
