

Picea omorika 'Pendula'



Height	8-10 m
Crown	narrow weeping
Bark and branches	dark brown, flaking bark, brown, hairy twigs
Leaf	needles glossy dark green, 0.5 - 2 cm, silvery grey underneath, evergreen
Flowers	inconspicuous, ? erect, long ovoid, purplish red, ? bright purplish red, may
Fruits	few cones
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	all, moisture-retentive and well-permeable
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), provides food for birds
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens
